



Stokeinteignhead School Uniform Policy

All children are expected to wear school uniform.

Our school uniform is:-

- School sweatshirt or sweat cardigan **with school logo** or plain navy cardigans.
- Yellow polo shirt **with school logo**.
- Grey/black shorts/trousers/skirts/pinafore dress.
- Children can wear blue gingham dresses in the summer.
- School shoes must be worn to school. These can be black sensible shoes, not trainers. But at break and lunchtimes children can wear trainers for running around.
- In the summer children can wear sturdy sandals which support their feet and have a back on them. Not flip flops.

PE KIT

PE kit can be worn on the day your child's class does PE.

- Plain white T shirt or T shirt with school logo.
- Plain navy black shorts (preferably not cycling shorts)
- Plimsolls or trainers (younger children need to have Velcro fasteners).
- A tracksuit may be worn in cold weather.

Swimming - children will need a swimming bag and towel. Boys will need plain swimming trunks or close fitting swimming shorts (baggy Bermuda type shorts can inhibit their ability to learn to swim and therefore children must not wear these). Girls will need a plain swimming costume.

NOTES

- Children are not to wear nail varnish or make up to school.
- Children with hair below their shoulders need to have their hair tied back during the school day for health and safety reasons.
- All children need to have sensible haircuts. Children's hair must not be dyed
- Hair bands/bows of school colours can be worn.
- Children can wear watches.
- For Health and Safety reasons, the only jewellery that will be permitted in school is stud earrings for pierced ears. These are to be restricted to one stud per ear and must either be removed or taped for PE and Games.

Sun Safe

During the summer months the children are encouraged to bring a hat and sun cream, (which they can apply themselves). Parents might consider using 'day-long' sun cream which can be applied before school. Sun cream must be of a high factor to protect their skin.
